Honor Master Photographers – The Lucie Awards (www.lucieawards.com) is the annual gala ceremony that celebrates master photographers and their contributions to the field of photography. 10 Honorees are determined each year in the following areas: Lifetime Achievement, Achievement in



Advertising, Achievement in Fine Art, Achievement in Documentary, Achievement in Fashion, Achievement in Photojournalism, Achievement in Sports, Achievement in Portraiture, Humanitarian Award & Visionary Award (these awards rotate each year), and Spotlight Award. 2009 Honorees include Fazal Sheikh, Gilles Peress, Jean Paul Goude and Marvin Newman. Sponsors include AtEdge, Blurb, Splashlight and PDN.

Discover and Cultivate Emerging Talent – The International Photography Awards (photoawards.com) is an annual, juried competition that is open to all photographers, both professional and non-professional, worldwide. Through the competition, three top honors are provided, one of which is The Discovery of the Year. This non-professional, emerging talent, stands out as tomorrow's bright star of the photography. This individual is given the title of Discovery of the Year, a \$5,000 cash prize, the Lucie statue and a solo exhibition at the Farmani Gallery, in New York.

Promote the Appreciation of Photography Worldwide. The Lucie Lecture Series – The East and West Coast Lucie Lecture Series features world-renowned, master photographers who have received or will receive Lucie Awards during the annual gala ceremony. The West Coast Series takes place during the Month of Photography Los Angeles and the East Coast Series takes place the days lead-

ing up to the Annual Lucie Awards Ceremony.

Month of Photography Los Angeles (MOPLA) – Created to advance the celebration of Photography through a variety of events and programs and designed to inspire and invigorate the photography professional, enthusiast, emerging professional and collector. In April 2009, the inaugural Month of Photography Los Angeles was introduced to showcase the enormous photography community, inclusive of commercial, fine art and photojournalism. As the second largest photography community in the United States, Los Angeles provides a distinctive backdrop to the celebration of the photographic image. (www.monthofphotography.com)

Fresh Fairs – a one-of-a-kind, juried photography fair for artists to exhibit and introduce their work directly to the collectors and the general public. The next installment of Fresh Fairs will take place in Miami from December 3 to 6.
